Our final iNet Event of our contract this year will be a networking event with a guided tour of the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway and the facilities provided for testing by Mytesttrack.com. For further information regarding the facilities please visit [www.e-v-r.com](http://www.e-v-r.com).

Our day will start with registration, teas and coffees at the Midland Hotel, Derby (next to the train station in Derby). Please note that named tickets will be given to those booking on to the event and are NOT transferable. As you can appreciate we will be limited on numbers attending this event so it will be on a first come first served basis. **Anyone booking to attend who does not attend on the day will be charged an admin fee of £25 plus VAT for non attendance.** A quick journey on an East Midlands Train to Duffield will follow. Wyvern Rail, the company behind Ecclesbourne Valley Railways and Mytesttrack.com will then provide for our journey from Duffield to Wirksworth an inspection special to illustrate the various physical features of their vehicles test business. Delegates will see work in progress as the line is renovated for the introduction of regular passenger trains.

On arrival at Wirksworth the Buffet Car will be open for teas & coffees prior to a walkthrough of the Wirksworth site with its various elements related to vehicle testing together with the historical features of what was a major departure point for limestone products. There will then be a short presentation prior to lunch aboard a former Gatwick Express vehicle.

During our time at Wirksworth there will be regular shuttles available over the short branch to Ravenstor travelling on the steepest gradient presently used by passenger trains in the UK.

Our day will conclude with a trip back on the inspection special to Duffield ready for our East Midlands Train back to Derby.
